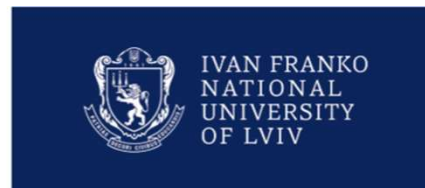

The Erasmus Gap project has documented the significant gap between students who can access mobility opportunities and those who cannot, often for socio-economic reasons.

Research Findings

In-depth research led by ELTE University has shed light on the factors widening this gap. It also highlighted the difficulty of quantifying socio-economic barriers to mobility with precise data across Europe.

Self-Assessment Tool (or toolkit)

A self-assessment tool was developed for Higher Education Institutions. It enables staff within the same institution to evaluate their mobility and inclusion strategies

Sharing of experiences and expertise

We are now entering a new phase of the project, which includes today's training. We are gathering perspectives and designing workshops with key stakeholders: students and HEI staff.

HOW TO PLAY

Please let's split into 3
groups of 13 / 14
participants (mixed groups
of students and staff
preferably)

- All participants start by standing.
- The facilitator reads out a sentence beginning with "Have you ever...?"
- If the statement applies to you, remain standing.
- If it does not apply, sit down.
- After each statement, the facilitator invites brief, spontaneous reactions from those still standing.

Example:

Have You ever studied abroad for more than 3 months?

If yes, remain standing

If not, sit down

**Have you ever experienced
culture shock?**

Have you ever helped an international student feel welcome?
