An intense Erasmus GAP project meeting took place from October 16 to 18 in Budapest, hosted by ELTE.

We had an in-depth discussion about the study results that are about to be published and will share them with you soon. One of the most important findings was that **it is not always the factors traditionally seen as barriers that create the gap between mobile and non-mobile students**. We should focus on the particular issues that higher education institutions can influence.

The consortium also looked at the following tasks to be implemented, including **the development of a self-assessment tool for institutions** to help them adapt a data-driven inclusion strategy, followed by the visualisation of the resulting data, as well as the organisation of study visits, national workshops and student training.

Our objective is twofold: to **provide institutions with a practical and illustrative tool**, while at the same time translating the lessons learned and data generated by the project into **policy advocacy activities**.
